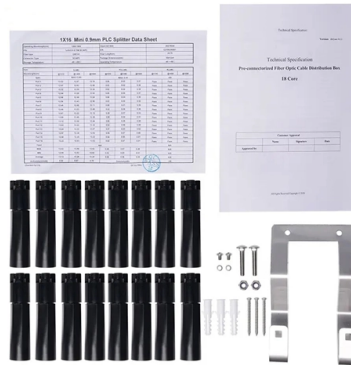

Getting this language right is the difference between a light that works and a dangerous situation involving short circuits, electrical shocks, or even fires.
